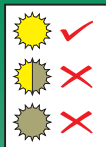


Hermetically Sealed in Foil for Freshness

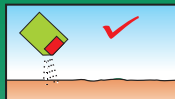

Both seeds are viable and perform with the same result. This pack could contain the flat oval, the "worm" type or both types of seed.
